1:22

- What does Peter say are the prerequisites for fulfilling the command to love one another? Why would these things be critical to loving others?
- What does it mean to love one another earnestly? (See 1 Corinthians 13:4–8a for a further explanation of this kind of love.)

1:23

- What does our status as born again add to our ability to love one another?
- Read John 1:12–13. How does this help us understand the seed analogy of this passage?
- What is the role of the Word of God?
- 1:24-25
 - What is the point of the flower analogy?
 - Why is it so important that the Word of the Lord remains forever?
- 2:1-3
 - How have you experienced the following in your relationships? Malice, deceit, hypocrisy, and envy.
 - What makes it possible for us to put these things away?
 - What is the pure spiritual milk that we should long for?

Application

- What have you experienced in this church that communicated love to you personally?
- What can you do today or in future weeks to show love to someone in this church?
- To whom do you need to communicate love? How will you communicate love to them? When will you do this?
